B.Ed. Admission 2017

- Online registration for B.Ed. Programme has been closed on 23 June 2017.
- **B.Ed. Entrance Examination is scheduled for 1st July 2017.**

Timings – 4:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. (Reporting Time at the examination centre is 3:00 p.m)

Applicants will have to download their admit cards from the PG portal of University of Delhi (<http://admission.du.ac.in/pg2017>)

- **Disclosure of Answer Key for MCQ Entrance examination and other related issues**
 1. The Department will upload the answer key of the entrance examination within 24 hours from the conclusion of the entrance examination.
 2. The applicant is required to visit the website to check the answer key vis-a-vis the question paper. In case of any discrepancy, the applicant concerned can register a complaint within 48 hours from time of uploading the answer key.
 3. The request for obtaining a copy of one's own ORS (OMR Response Sheet) by the applicant must be made within 7 calendar days from the date of declaration of results to the University in the prescribed format along with a fee of Rs. 500/ per paper.
- **Reservation of Seats for OBC (Non -Creamy Layer, Central List)**
 1. **The OBC applicants who belong to the 'Non-Creamy Layer' and whose caste appears in the Central List of the OBCs only, shall be eligible to be considered for admission under the OBC category. The validity of the non -creamy layer certificate shall be for the financial year 2017-18.**
 2. If the applicants do not have the OBC non-creamy layer certificate of the financial year 2017-2018 at the time of upload, the applicant may upload old OBC non- creamy layer certificate. However at the time of admission the applicant will have to produce the OBC non-creamy layer certificate of the financial year 2017-2018.
 3. The OBC applicants shall be given a relaxation of 10% in the minimum eligibility marks for the said programme. In the admission entrance examination, OBC applicants will also be given a relaxation of 10% of the minimum eligibility marks prescribed for Unreserved

category.

- **In case of a tie in the entrance examination, the rule followed will be as given below:**
 1. In case the applicants secure equal marks in the Entrance examination, an applicant who has secured higher percentage of marks in the qualifying examination, as mentioned in the eligibility condition, and stated in the online registration form, will be considered first for admissions.
 2. Further, if the applicants have secured equal marks in the qualifying examination, class XII marks will be considered for deciding merit.

- **The following procedure will be followed for applicants whose 'results are awaited' at the time of declaration of admission list:**
 1. For admission to post graduate programme where admission is based on entrance mode, the applicants of School of Open Learning (SOL) , University of Delhi, whose results are not declared may be given provisional admission with undertaking that they will submit their results at least seven days (23-8-2017) before the last date of admission in University of Delhi, i.e., 31-8-2017.
 2. For admission to postgraduate programmes where admission is entirely based on Entrance mode, applicants who do not have their migration certificates at the time of admission, may be given provisional admission with the undertaking that they will submit migration certificate at least seven days (23rd August 2017) before the last date of admissions in University of Delhi, i.e., 31st August, 2017.

- **Applicants who apply to the sub-category 'other' under the category of 'gender' will be admitted only to co-educational institutions.**

- **All applicants shall be considered at par, irrespective of their year of passing of the qualifying examination, for admission to all postgraduate programmes.**

- **Up gradation to another institution for B.Ed. Programme in the subsequent merit list is not permitted .** The institution allocated will not be changed. Allocation of institution will be based on the rank in the entrance examination in their respective category, subject category and applicant's preference of the institutions.
