AIWEFA - INTRODUCTION

Steeped in the annals of India's history, the All India Women's Education Fund Association (AIWEFA) celebrates 90 years in women's education and community development.

Education was recognized as the catalytic agent for social change, and in 1932, AIWEFA established the Lady Irwin College, New Delhi to bring a scientific temper in women's education.

Conferred with the Special Consultative Status (ECOSOC) by the United Nations and Observer Status with UNFCCC, AIWEFA's programmes have evolved in response to the needs of different decades-from education, health and nutrition to cyber security; intergenerational bonding and safe car driving initiatives for underprivileged women; climate change to sustainable development goals.
