**INDIVIDUALS (Consultants/ Interns/ Volunteers)**

Roshni – Centre for Women Collectives Led Social Action is housed in the Department of Development Communication and Extension, Lady Irwin College. The Centre functions as a semi-autonomous centre governed by the administration and governing body norms of Lady Irwin College, as per University Grant Commission norms. The seed grant to start the centre has been provided by UNICEF India. The Centre team is a Chairperson (Director, Lady Irwin College), a Faculty Lead (Permanent Faculty of Department of Development Communication and Extension, Lady Irwin College) and team of Consultants (on contractual basis) and development partners. The Centre has been serving as technical support unit to DAY-NRLM for knowledge management, policy and convening support for food, nutrition, health, family planning, gender-transformative work and WASH interventions with and for women self-help groups and their federation network under DAY-NRLM. The Centre is now diversifying its portfolio in media documentation (print, film, social media) works around maternal nutrition efforts with women collectives and initiating a nested evaluation in UNICEF supported initiative Swabhimaan across 3 Indian states in following two areas – (a) engaging men and boys for working with boys and men on issues related to Patriarchy, femission and power and legal rights of women and (b) working with adolescent boys and girls on mental health aspects, addressing child marriage and child pregnancy.

The Centre is, hence, opening this call window of expression of interest from individuals and agencies to be engaged as full time/ part-time/ assignment basis with the Roshni-Centre of Women Collectives led Social Action for the following positions/ portfolios based on experience:

**1. Process documentation (2 positions - Consultant Research)**

**Sub-activities:** This task entails site visits to develop case studies on stories of change, preparation of annual reports across sites and compilation of reports, designing and implementing studies on women collectives in sites.

**Profile being sought:** Masters/ Ph.D. in Anthropology/ Nutrition/ Population Sciences/ Agriculture Extension/ Rural Management/ Communications/ Journalism/ International Development, with at least 2+ of experience post masters in research, managing field research, trainings, data analysis and writing academic papers who can commit full time to the Centre. Position will require outstation travel.

(Remunerations will be based upon years of relevant experience and level of expertise of the individual)

2. **Website, Films and Social Media (2 positions: Consultant – Communication)**

**Sub-activities:** This task entails creation and management of web content, blogs writing, conversion of text material into simplified communication and working with agencies empanelled for development of films for the centre and Swabhimaan demonstration site activities entails site visits to develop case studies on stories of change, preparation of annual reports across sites and compilation of reports.

**Profile being sought:** Masters in Journalism/ International Development, with at least 2+ of experience post masters in journalistic research, development of films, coffee table books, advocacy materials, development of IEC material who can commit full time to the Centre. Position will require outstation travel.

(Remunerations will be based upon years of relevant experience and level of expertise of the individual)

3. **Six-month fellowship (4 per year):** Candidate who are fresh Masters in Journalism/ International Development/ Rural Management/ Film Making and are willing to learn and be engaged in research, field work and activities of the centre.

(Fee: Upto INR 20000 per month)

4. **Internship (4 per year):** Candidates who are pursuing their Bachelors/ Masters in Communication/ International Development and willing to be engaged in specific activities of the Centre on a time-bound activity. Based on the level of the time and effort, will be provided a certification of work at centre.

(Travel support shall be provided should there be any field work necessities)

All positions stated above are on contractual basis for two years, renewal based on availability of project funds and performance. A lock-in period of 6 months is mandatory for all the above-mentioned positions.
