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VACANCY ANNOUNCEMENT

ROSHNI – Centre for Women Collectives Led Social Action (ROSHNI-CWCSA) is housed in the Department of Development Communication and Extension, Lady Irwin College, New Delhi. The Centre functions as a semi-autonomous centre governed by the administration and governing body norms of Lady Irwin College, as per University Grant Commission norms. The seed grant to start the centre has been provided by UNICEF India. The Centre team is a Chairperson (Director, Lady Irwin College), a Faculty Lead (Permanent Faculty of Department of Development Communication and Extension, Lady Irwin College) and team of Consultants (on contractual basis) and development partners.

The Centre has been also been serving as technical support unit to DAY-NRLM for knowledge management, policy and convening support for food, nutrition, health, family planning, WASH on one hand and gender integration in various NRLM verticals as well as gender-transformative work with men and boys.

For the gender integration work within various verticals of NRLM, **a mid-level consultant** is to be positioned in NRLM to be working day to day with the gender and SISD focal point at NRLM.

This advertisement is an open call to suitable candidates with work experience in working in both NRLM at national/state levels as well as gender work with women collectives for the said position.

Job description (details are as under):

- Participate and contribute in the gender mainstreaming/ integration, state/ district workshops of NRLM/NIRD. Serve as a resource person, as needed.
- Support review and enhancement of Gender MIS of NRLM
- Review and document the gender mainstreaming activities of states as committed under Annual Action Plan
- Participate and support in organizing gender related workshop/reviews/symposiums.
- Document innovative work around gender work within NRLM for ripples/sharing

Day to day reporting and reporting officer: NRLM Team and Joint Secretary

Monthly reporting for seeking and sharing technical updates: ROSHNI Centre (Lead of Centre)

Remuneration: Rs. 30,000-50,000 per month, based on experience and expertise.

Number of positions: One

Tenure: One year, contractual. Initial hiring will be till 31.12.2019. Renewable, based on funding and performance. (A lock-in period of 6 months is mandatory)

Qualification:

Essential: Masters in Gender/ Women Studies/ Community Development Studies or related field. At least two years of post-master's work experience with village women organizations. Published verifiable work for documentation experience.

Desirable: A Ph.D. holder or at least 2-3 years post-master experience in managing community-centred projects or research on gender-based interventions. Published in peer reviewed international/national journals and developed project monitoring reports.

Only shortlisted candidates will be called for pre-interview written test(s) and interview in-person, as per discretion of the interview committee. Recruitment process may be multi-stage.

GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. All educational professional and technical qualifications should be from a recognized Board/ University and full-time.
2. The experience requirement specified should be experience acquired after obtaining the minimum educational qualifications required for the post.
3. Persons working in Govt. or Public Sector undertaking should produce "No Objection Certificate" at the time of Interview.
4. The qualification, experience and other requirements for the posts may be relaxed at the discretion of the competent authority, in case of candidates who are otherwise suitable. Candidates not found suitable for the posts notified, can be offered a lower post on the recommendation of the Selection Committee.
5. No TA/DA will be admissible to appear in the interview. No calls shall be entertained.
6. Candidates who can join immediately should apply, as the position is to be filled on an urgent basis.
7. The positions will be purely on temporary/contractual basis for the specified period of time and based on project.
