FAQs

1. What are the college admission requirements?

- A. A student should check if she meets the eligibility criteria for the course and submit the required testimonials. All admissions are done at the level of the University.

2. What is the eligibility criterion for admission to M.Sc. courses of Home Science?

- A. Each specialization has its own eligibility requirements for admission. Visit Lady Irwin College website (<http://www.ladyirwin.edu.in/>), IHE website (<http://ihe.du.ac.in/>) and refer to University of Delhi PG bulletin on website (<http://www.du.ac.in/>) for details.

3. How many seats are available in M.Sc. courses of Home Science?

- A. Visit Lady Irwin College website (<http://www.ladyirwin.edu.in/>), IHE website (<http://ihe.du.ac.in/>) and refer to University of Delhi PG bulletin on website (<http://www.du.ac.in/>) for details of total number of seats and category-wise seat distribution for all specializations offered.

4. What is the eligibility criterion for Merit based admission?

- A. Students pursuing B.Sc. (Hons) Home Science from University of Delhi in the academic year (2021-2022) are eligible for admission under Merit based category. Other students can apply for admission through Entrance.

5. I am a student of B.Sc. (Hons) Home Science. Do I need to sit for the Entrance exam for admission to M.Sc. courses?

- A. It is highly recommended that **ALL** honours students appear for the Entrance exam as merit based seats are limited. Honours students who apply only for merit based admission and do not give the entrance exam will be eligible for admission under Merit based category ONLY.

6. I am a student of B.Sc. (Pass) Home Science. Am I eligible for Merit based admission?

- A. No. Only students pursuing B.Sc. (Hons) Home Science from University of Delhi in the academic year (2021-2022) are eligible for admission under Merit based category. All other students can apply for admission through Entrance.

7. I am an ex-student (2018 batch) with an Honours degree in Home Science from University of Delhi. Am I eligible for Merit based admission?

A. No. Only students pursuing B.Sc. (Hons) Home Science from University of Delhi in the academic year (2021-2022) are eligible for admission under Merit based category. Students of all previous batches can apply for admission through Entrance ONLY.

8. Can students who have taken a gap year apply for M.Sc. courses in Home Science?

A. Yes. Students who have taken a gap year can apply for admission to M.Sc. courses in Home Science through Entrance ONLY.

9. Can a student apply to more than one M.Sc. course?

A. Yes. Admission is subject to fulfillment of eligibility in those courses.

10. Are students studying in other universities eligible for admission to M.Sc. courses of Home Science in University of Delhi?

A. Yes. All students who fulfill the eligibility criteria can apply for admission to M.Sc. course of their choice through Entrance ONLY.

11. In case of non-availability of eligible candidates, can EWS seats be converted to UR?

A. Please visit University of Delhi website for information.

12. In case of non-availability of eligible candidates, is there is a provision for interchangeability of reserved seats?

A. Please refer to University of Delhi PG bulletin.

13. Can I change the college allotted to me?

A. This is subject to availability of seat. Please refer to University of Delhi PG bulletin.

14. How many days are given for paying the fee after the name comes on the list?

A. Payment of fee schedule is announced by the University. It is usually 2-3 days.

15. How will we know when each admission list will come out?

A. The student gets notified on their own portal if they have been shortlisted.
