Other saplings were planted by senior faculty of the college, Prof. (Dr.) Meenakshi Mital, Head Department of Resource Management and Design Application, Convenor of the event, Prof. (Dr.) Rupa Upadhyaya, Convenor, Garden Committee, Lady Irwin College, Ms. Mitali Yadav, Assistant professor, Department of Resource Management and Design Application, Ms. Shefali Chopra, Assistant professor, Department of Resource Management and

As the weather was conducive for fruit and flowering trees, the saplings which were planted included Mango, Pomegranate, Wood Apple, Cascabela thevetia (Kaner), Carandas, Tecoma and Jatropha. Over the year, as per the seasonal conditions, 55 more trees will be planted including fruit trees like chicoo, lichi, and traditional trees like, neem, kadamb, Banyan etc. The event was attended and applauded by teaching and non-teaching staff, and students of Lady Irwin College.
