Her major publications over the years include chapters in edited books and journal articles on the themes of children's developmental understanding of truth, Psychobiography of Indira Gandhi, cultural origins and directions of decision making, development in middle childhood and adolescence, children's construals of happiness, and research on the young child in India. She has also created modules on early childhood development for UNICEF Gandhinagar.
