Activities of the ICC

In the year 2023-24, IC stood by its purpose and worked on fulfilling the mission of its existence through sensitization and awareness programs for prevention of sexual harassment at the workplace.

The year brought about the offline working of the institution as well as the IC. The campus reopened for all the students and staff. IC members remained abreast to make sure that campus remains a safe place for every individual, this year we began with a motive to build a sensitized community of young people and encouraged the students to join IC in the volunteering capacity. The volunteers were enriched with the understanding about the grave concern of "sexual harassment at workplace", the purpose of ICC at workplace, and their role of creating further awareness in their classrooms, peer groups and campus as a whole.

Regular meetings were convened with the student representatives of the IC to chalk out the events for the year; follow-up meetings were held to see the flawless implementation of the plans.

The year **2023-24** witnessed the active engagement of student volunteers in competitions as well as off-campus workshops for virtual sensitization and awareness programmes for prevention of sexual harassment at workplace with active involvement of the IC student representatives. IC continued to make its presence felt on social media platforms like Instagram and Facebook. The social media handles were created to spread awareness and reach to maximum number of Irwinites, and be easily approachable to them. The representatives along with the volunteers, under the guidance of the Chairperson, managed the social media page and posted information about sexual harassment at workplace, the role, purpose and functions of ICC and other information regarding the engagement activities conducted by the IC. A combination of posts, posters, interactive stories and reels were created to spread awareness and sensitize people in an easy and comprehensive manner.

IC collaborated with all the 15 (student-headed) cultural societies and other members of the Students' Association of the college to make people aware about the purpose and presence of IC in the campus and workplace as a whole. All the 15 societies, a core part of the Students' Association passed on the word that they "stand against sexual harassment at workplace" as a unified whole. In the year 2023-2024, the Internal Committee of Lady Irwin College continued its efforts to promote awareness and address issues related to women's safety. The year commenced with a workshop on POST ACT Awareness and training program on August 11, 2023, attended by Ph.D. Rep Nidhi Marothiya and Prof. Shraddha Kapoor. On August 17, 2023, the IC presented its activities during the orientation program for new students. In collaboration with the Women Development Cell, a self-defense workshop was organized on September 25, 2023, led by Shri Ashok Chugh, a former Delhi police coach. To commemorate International Women's Day on March 8, 2024, the IC held a painting competition and a seminar on women's safety, focusing on the role of the Delhi police. Additionally, in collaboration with the Women Development Cell, a slogan-writing competition was organized on the theme of menstrual leave, with prizes awarded to the winners. These initiatives collectively contributed to raising awareness, promoting safety, and empowering students within the college community.

The ICC had a great year generating awareness regarding IC and its activities with a team of dedicated student representatives and volunteers.




