>>>> GREEN INITIATIVES AND ENVIRONMENTAL SENSITIZATION

Lady Irwin College, through its curriculum and green initiatives has set an example in the areas of environmental sensitization. A number of green initiatives have been undertaken by the college. One of the most noteworthy initiatives towards this is the installation of 218 kWp solar power plant on college rooftops, meeting about 80%-90% of its energy requirements. Each initiative addresses several targets and the college takes pride in its various sustainability practices and aims to continuously improve its sustainability quotient.
