



2.6.2 Attainment of Programme outcomes and course outcomes are evaluated by the institution.




For assessment of Attainment of program outcome of B.sc Hons 2021 data was collected from 101 students. Average of SGPA was taken out of I, II and III semesters. As shown in this graph 8 % students have SGPA in the range of 9-10, 53% students are in 8.9-8 SGPA, 27% students have SGPA in the range of 7.9-7, 11% has SGPA in the range of 6.9-6 % and only 1% has SGPA 5.9. So 88 % students have an average of SGPA above 6.9.



For assessment of Attainment of program outcome of B.sc Hons 2021 data was collected from 110 students. SGPA was taken out of semester I. As shown in this graph 19% students have SGPA in the range of 9-10, 58% students are in 8.9-8 SGPA, 16% students have SGPA in the

range of 7.9-7, 6% have SGPA in the range of 6.9-0 % .So 93 % students have an average of SGPA above 6.9.



For assessment of Attainment of program outcome of B.sc Pass 2021 data was collected from 281 students. Average of SGPA was taken out of I, II and III semesters. As shown in this graph 1% students have SGPA in the range of 9-10, 23% students are in 8.9-8 SGPA, 46% students have SGPA in the range of 7.9-7, 21% have SGPA in the range of 6.9-6 % and 9% students are in range of 5.9-0. So 70% students have an average of SGPA above 6.9.
