PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Research papers will be preferred for paper presentation.



ABSTRACT

The abstract should not exceed 300 words and must include the title, objectives, methodology, summary of results, implications, author(s) name, designation, institutional affiliation, mailing address, contact number and email ID. Abstract should be typed in English (Times New Roman, font size 12) / Hindi (Krutidev, size 14) with 1.5 line spacing and sent via email.



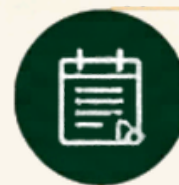
FULL PAPER

The full paper should be between 3000 to 5000 words (including tables, figures, references etc.). The paper should be typed in English (Times New Roman, font size 12) / Hindi (Krutidev, size 14) with 1.5 line spacing in APA 7th edition format.

Only selected full-length papers, submitted as per the prescribed guidelines and recommended through the review process, shall be considered for publication in an **Edited Book/Conference Proceedings with ISBN/ISSN number**. Selection for publication shall be based on quality, originality, relevance to the conference theme, and reviewers' recommendations. The decision of the Editorial Board regarding publication shall be final. Outstanding papers may additionally be considered for publication in **Scopus-indexed journals/edited volumes**, subject to the scope, editorial policies, and review requirements of the respective publication outlet. **Publication charges, if applicable, shall be borne by the author(s).**
